

# Science Fair Information

## Grade 5

- Project is **MANDATORY**
- 5th graders may choose to complete a project using the Hopewell guidelines OR the Chester County Fair guidelines

## Grade 6

- Project is **OPTIONAL**
- 6th graders who participate must complete a project under the Chester County Fair guidelines

## HOPEWELL PROJECT GUIDELINES

- Will be a major science grade for grade 5
- Will follow guidelines created for Hopewell Elementary School **ONLY**
- Projects will be displayed in the hallways during STEM Night for families to view

## CHESTER COUNTY PROJECT GUIDELINES

- Will be a major science grade
- Will follow guidelines created by the Chester County Intermediate Unit and will follow strict rules and regulations
- Projects will be displayed in the hallways during STEM Night for families to see
- Will be scored by judges from Hopewell - the winners will go on to represent Hopewell Elementary School at the Chester County Science Fair

- Packets for the county science fair will be given to students by Mr. Neff, STEM Teacher
- Only grade 5 students will receive a grade for their project, but this project will also be eligible for the Chester County Science Fair. Projects will be scored by a panel of judges at Hopewell and the top five projects from grade 5 and grade 6 will go on to represent Hopewell at the county level.
- County projects will be supported by Mr. Neff, not the homeroom teacher.
- There is specific paperwork that must be completed before students can begin their projects.

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**Students must choose whether they plan to do a project using Hopewell guidelines or a project using County guidelines by:**

**Tuesday, NOVEMBER 20**
